- Wolves: Call of the Wild 1, 6; Paws on the Path 1, 2, 3, 4
- Bears: Bear Necessities 1, 4 (completes requirements)

Weekend day hike at a nature center:

- Wolves: Paws on the Path 5 (completes adventure); Grow Something 2, 3; Spirit of the Water 1, 2
- Bears: Fur, Feathers, and Ferns: 1, 2, 3, 4 (completes adventure)
- Can also be used towards World Conservation Award (coordinate in advance with venue to do service project)

Den Saturday:

- Bears: Bear Claws/Whittling Chip
- *Follow my guide from my Bear yearly plan (<http://improvscouter.us/yearly-plans/a-bear-year-of-necessities/>) as this won't work for anything with Wolves.*

Community Service Project

- Wolves: Council Fire 2 (completes requirements)
- Can be done outside of den meeting or as part of Pack activity

Meeting 1:

- Wolves: Council Fire 1
- Bears: Paws for Action 1, 2A (use Betsy Ross and Francis Scott Key to tie into the flag learning)

Meeting 2 - Site Visit (Law Enforcement):

- Wolves: Council Fire 3; Hometown Heroes 2
- Bears: Paws for Action 3A, 3B (completes requirements); Forensics 4A

Meeting 3:

- Wolves: Howling at the Moon 1, 2
- Bears: Roaring Laughter 1, 2

Meeting 4:

- Wolves: Howling at the Moon 3
- Bears: Roaring Laughter 5, 6 (first part)

Meeting 5 (at Pack Meeting):

- Wolves: Howling at the Moon 4 (completes requirements)
- Bears: Roaring Laughter 6 (second part)

Meeting 6:

- Wolves: Running with the Pack 4
- Bears: Grin and Bear it 1

Meeting 7:

- *Have the Bears plan a "carnival" for the Wolves to run through and complete their requirements*
- Wolves: Running with the Pack 1, 2, 3, 5
- Bears: Grin and Bear it 2, 3, 4 (completes requirements)

Meeting 8:

- Homework at a previous meeting to be brought in to this one:
- Wolves: Running with the Pack 6 (completes requirements)
- Bears: Bear Picnic Basket 2, 3, 4 (completes requirements)
- *This is probably good for a December meeting in advance of Christmas depending upon how many times you might be meeting that month*

Meeting 9:

- Wolves: Grow Something 1
- Bears: Baloo the Builder 1, 2

Meeting 10: Build a birdhouse or bird feeder

- Wolves: World Conservation Award (if donated)
- Bears: Baloo the Builder 3, World Conservation Award 3
- *This requires different activities being done concurrently*

Meeting 11:

- Wolves: Grow Something 4C (completes requirements when growth logs are done; completes World Conservation Award requirements)
- Bears: Baloo the Builder 4 (completes requirements)
- *This requires different activities being done concurrently*

Meeting 12:

- Wolves: Air of the Wolf 2A, 2B
- Bears: A World of Sound 3

Meeting 13:

- Wolves: Air of the Wolf 1A; Motor Away 1A, 1B
- Bears: A World of Sound 1
- *This requires different activities being done concurrently - get parents to help supervise*

Meeting 14:

- Wolves: Air of the Wolf 1C or 1D (completes requirements)
- Bears: A World of Sound 2 (completes requirements)
- *This requires different activities being done concurrently - get parents to help supervise*

Meeting 15:

- Wolves: Hometown Heroes 4B (Homework 1)
- Bears: Critter Care 2B (Homework 1A or 1B)

Meeting 16: Bring in a Speaker from local animal welfare agency

- Wolves: Hometown Heroes 3 (completes requirements)
- Bears: Critter Care 3A/3B (completes requirements when 1A or 1B is done)
