Passages to be Read

Introduction

Jesus Blesses the Children – Matthew 19:13-15

Section 1: God Created Me

Children will study the creation story and learn that God was pleased with all creation. They will acknowledge God as Creator and give praise to God.

God Said That It Was Good – Genesis 1:1 – 2:3

God Calls Me by Name - Isaiah 43:1-2 & 4

Praise God! - Isaiah 44:23

Section 2: Jesus is God's Gift to Me

Children will learn of God's love through Jesus. As they tell parallel stories of their own birth and the birth of Jesus, they will proclaim that Jesus was born to be their Savior.

Jesus Is Born - Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-34; Luke 2:1-20; Matthew 2:2-12

Jesus Was Born to Be a Savior - John 3:16

Section 3: I Can Talk with God

Children will learn how important prayer was to Jesus and that God wants them to pray. They will learn four parts of prayer to help them share their thoughts with God. Children will be required to memorize the Lord's Prayer.

Jesus Prays - Mark 1:35-37

The Lord's Prayer - Matthew 6:9-13

God Talks to Samuel - 1 Samuel 3:1-10

Section 4: Because God Cares for Me, I Can Care for Others

As children learn to lean on God as their Good Shepherd, they will be challenged to reach out and be "good shepherds" to those around them.

Jesus Is the Good Shepherd - Matthew 18:12-14

Jesus Is a Friend to All - Luke 19:1-10

Homework Items

Section 1: God Created Me

Say a blessing before family meals

Make a poster to show the important people, places and happenings in your life

Section 2: Jesus is God's Gift to Me

Have a family night. Watch home videos or look through photos albums together. Share stories about growing up.

Section 3: I Can Talk with God

Get up early one morning with your family to take a prayer walk. Look for things to pray about (flowers, neighbors, family). At the end of your walk, read Psalm 67 together.

Section 4: Because God Cares for Me, I Can Care for Others

Look at the list of ways to be friendly with people on page 28. Choose one or two of these activities to do. Talk with your family about how it feels to help other people. Talk with your family about what it means to share God's love with others. (Section 4)
