Welcome to Pack 295, we are thrilled to have you join us! You'll quickly learn we're an active Pack that enjoy working through our adventures together. Our Pack meets every Tuesday at 7 pm year round following the school year. There will be typically three den meetings and one pack meeting per month. In June and July, we will hold one to two activities but no regular meetings.

For those new to Scouting, our dens are based upon grade level:

- Lions: Kindergarten

- Bears: Third Grade
- Webelos: Fourth Grade

We also offer a STEM program, NOVA, for Wolves through Arrow of Light. The NOVA den meets twice a month on Tuesdays at 6:15 (before den meetings).

In addition to our meetings, we participate in district/council campouts each year at Black Creek Scout Reservation in Sylvania, and typically offer one Pack/Den outing each month.

Pack 295 is a family pack, and parents are expected to attend den and pack meetings and outings with their Cubs. Parents are also invited to join the Pack Committee and will be asked to help in various capacities throughout the year.

We are also a very sports-friendly Pack, so if your Cub is playing a sport, that is ok. Your den leader will work with you and your Cub to help make their rank.
