

PRAY Religious Emblems

Duty to God is a cornerstone of the Scouting program. The Scout Oath begins with duty to God; the Scout Law ends with reverence. The BSA recognizes that religious instruction comes from the family and faith community. The P.R.A.Y. Award is the linchpin connecting scouting and churches to benefit young people. The result is stronger youth, stronger families, stronger congregations, and stronger councils.

As of August 1, 2019, the PRAY religious emblems have had a few changes as follows:

- Jesus and Me Lions and Tigers
- God and Me Wolves and Bears
- God and Family Webelos and Arrow of Light

God and Me was offered in spring 2019 so will not be offered this year. God and Family will be offered as part of the Pack campout on September 27-29. Jesus and Me will be offered as part of the Pack campout November 15-17.
