



Fees & Fundraisers

Registration Fees

Your registration fee is prorated from now until the end of December. This fee is \$15.

If your child has insurance through Amerigroup, the insurance company will pay the registration fee. You will need to provide a copy of your child's insurance card with their membership application.

In January, your yearly registration fee will be \$51 per Scout.

If you are in need of financial assistance for your yearly registration fee, please complete our scholarship application.

Popcorn Fundraiser (Fall)

This fall, your Scout will participate in our annual popcorn fundraiser. Each Scout that sells a minimum of \$400 will have their membership fees paid for the next year (2020). Scouts will be able to sell the popcorn online as well as retail locations on certain weekends as well as to local friends and family.

The popcorn fundraiser helps to pay for our local council and insurance. This fundraiser helps to keep annual registration fees low.

BBQ (March)

Each March, the Pack and Troop hold a BBQ fundraiser at the Guyton United Methodist Church. This fundraiser gets split between the Pack and Troop based upon ticket sales from each. 100% of the funds raised stay with the units. The Pack uses these funds to help pay for awards as well as subsidize meals and gear on campouts and other Pack activities.

Camp Cards (Spring)

In the spring, Cubs will sell cards to help pay for summer camp. 50% of each card sold goes into the Cub's "account" with the Pack. Those funds may be used toward summer camp or any Pack outing through the year, or uniform or other Scout Store purchases.
